- All applications will be reviewed and assessed by an Annual Awards
 Committee made up of SOV/LETR and an Independent Person with lived experience of Disability.
- The top 6 applicants will then be invited to attend a 10 minute interview with the committee above. You may have a support person present. Further details will be provided in regards to the time/date and location if you are successful. (Early August Date TBC)
- The Annual Awards Committee will assess the interviews and applications and decide the three award winners for 2025.

Award winners will be notified on the morning of 29th August, 2024.

Results will be published on internal and external media after the Gala Ball.
